In order to qualify, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

- ✚ Must live in Caroline County, Virginia
- ✚ Must be accepted into a college or institute of higher learning
- ✚ Must have fulfilled one or more of the Five Promises through community service that benefited the local community
- ✚ Must complete the application and submit essays addressing the two application questions
- ✚ Must submit at least one letter of recommendation from an individual who has knowledge of their community service efforts
- ✚ Application must be received no later than **April 15, 2012.**
